## DESIGN

Every sensational batch of cookies begins with a recipe. Will it be chocolate chip, oatmeal raisin, or macaroon? The choice is yours. Once you decide, send it to us: type, images, logos, and layout.

# Well, it's kind of like baking cookies...

#### PLANNING

Now that you have the recipe, will you need a baker's dozen, a hundred dozen, some for the freezer? Talk with our seasoned staff about saving time and money with a little creative energy.

#### EDIT / PREP

We check the ingredients, to make sure the recipe will turn out the quality you want:

The design is properly formatted for our presses.
The dimensions work for the project.
The fonts are available.
Colors are consistent with CMYK (Cyan-Magenta-Yellow-Black) or PMS (Pantone Matching System) standards.

#### **PRINT RUN**

The plates go into the printing press for "baking". The printer applies ink in layers – depending on whether it is a 2- or 4-color process job – and at varying consistencies to produce the colors you've asked for.

# **POST-PRESS WORK**

We add sprinkles and icing, according to the recipe, and shape the batch. This step includes trimming, folding, stitching, perforating, collating, and otherwise custom binding for your product.

# **DELIVERY / SHIPPING**

The cookies go into the cookie jar. We package and box the batch per instructions and ship or deliver it to you for everyone to enjoy!

## ELECTRONIC STRIPPING

We break out the mixing bowl... and arrange your pages.

#### PROOFING

Now that your dough is in the works, it's time for a tasting! We send you digital and/or printed proofs to let you sample the finished product and make refinements.

# **PLATING...** ...puts the dough onto cookie sheets as the final images go onto a series

of metal plates, one for each CYMK color.
